

Monday 7th May

7.30am ♦ Breakfast

Start the day with a 'Morris Dancer Breakfast' in the crypt of St. Mary Star of the Sea from 7.30-9.00am. Proceeds to 'The Two Towers Trust'.

9.45am ♦ The Gathering

The Morris sides, the Bogies, the Sweeps and a whole host of other characters start to gather at the Net Huts in Rock-a-Nore Road in the Old Town. The greening begins here!

10.15am ♦ Jack is Released

To a chorus of Bogie drummers the Jack is released from the Fishermen's Museum in Rock-a-Nore Road, where Mad Jack's women perform their magical dance around him. The procession begins. After Jack and his attendant Bogies come Mad Jack's Morris men and women, the Sweeps and May Queen, Hannah's Cat, The Lovely Ladies and Gay Bogies, Section 5 with guests Mirabilia from Berlin, visiting Morris sides and Giants, Sambalanco, Green Participants and RumbleDrumskin.

11.15am ♦ Dancing in High Street

After moving through the Old Town, Jack and the procession pause for refreshment and dancing in the High Street. There will be morris dancing and drumming at various locations between Swan Gardens and The FILO. ♦ May we ask that everyone be patient and mindful of other people at this point as the High Street is likely to be very busy and moving about will be difficult. It is safest if onlookers get to a viewing point before the procession arrives and then stay at that point, if possible, for the duration of the break. The procession reforms at 11.45am and restarts at 12.00pm. From this point the route will turn up Swan Terrace, turn past St. Clements Church moving up Croft Road, along Collier Road and across the West Hill into the Castle grounds.

Please be aware that the procession route is the same as last year and is as follows:
Fishermen's Museum, All Saints Street, across the Bourne, High Street - break for refreshments - Swan Terrace, Croft Road, Collier Road, Priory Road, Ladies Parlour, Castle.
